## **Sustainability**





In our focus upon sustainability, we have divided the topic into the following three themes: waste, noise and mobility.

In the start of September, we celebrated the **Mobility week** and invited parents and staff who access the school with either public transport, on foot or by bike for a coffee in the morning. It was a great start to the day, thank you to all the parents and staff who attended this event.

As our school is quite overcrowded, noise is one of our main concerns, we are thus working on raising the children's awareness to how each and every one of us can contribute to a calmer working environment. So far there has been several successful initiatives in the Nursery, where they have developed a Noise Detecting Machine registering all the different noises surrounding us.

In the Nursery and Primary cycle, we try once a month to make different activities with focus upon how to reduce the noise in our school.

As a project for the whole school we have applied for the **Eco Label** and all stakeholders; students (from Primary and secondary cycles) teachers and staff, parents, Atalian, canteen, busses etc. are taking part in this important project. We follow the methodology of *Bruxelles Environment* and for the first time **we have created an ECO Committee in the Primary cycle.** 

We were thrilled to learn that our school was awarded the Eco Label in October 2023. Well done to all involved.

Finally, we have placed a lot of focus on waste and we are currently preparing for the "Semaine Européenne des déchets".

We are very proud of all our pupils and their involvement and commitment to working towards a more sustainable future in our school.
