Improvisation

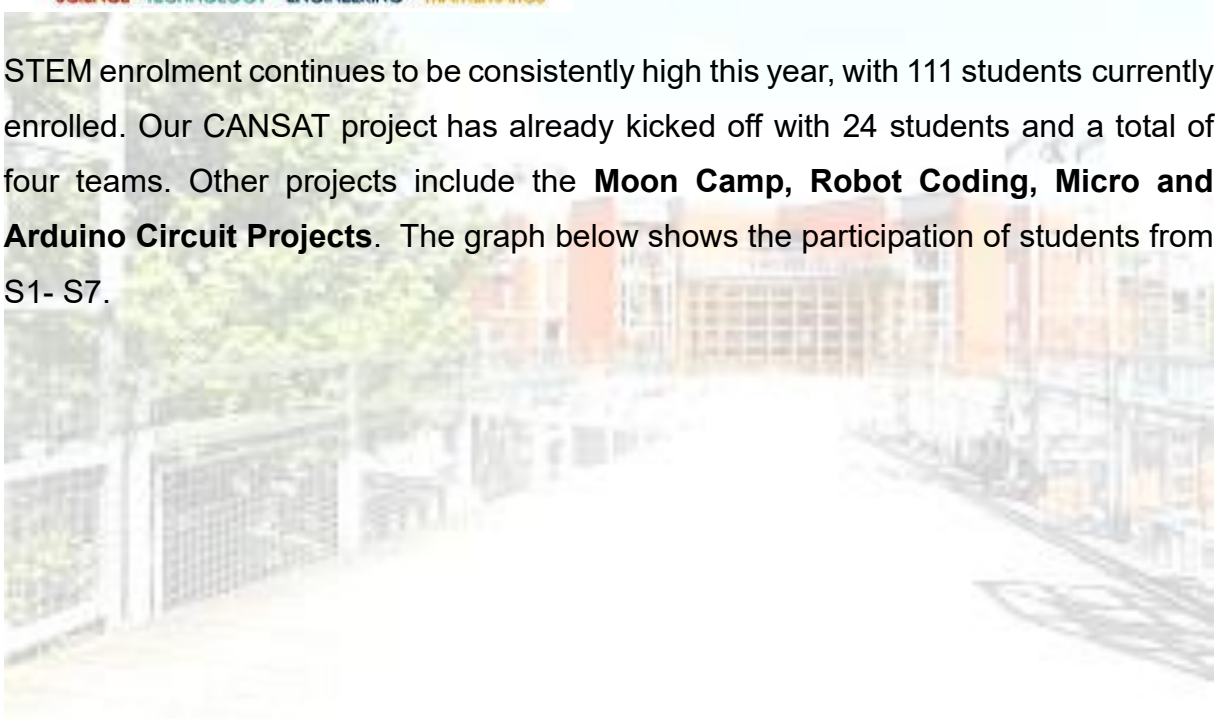

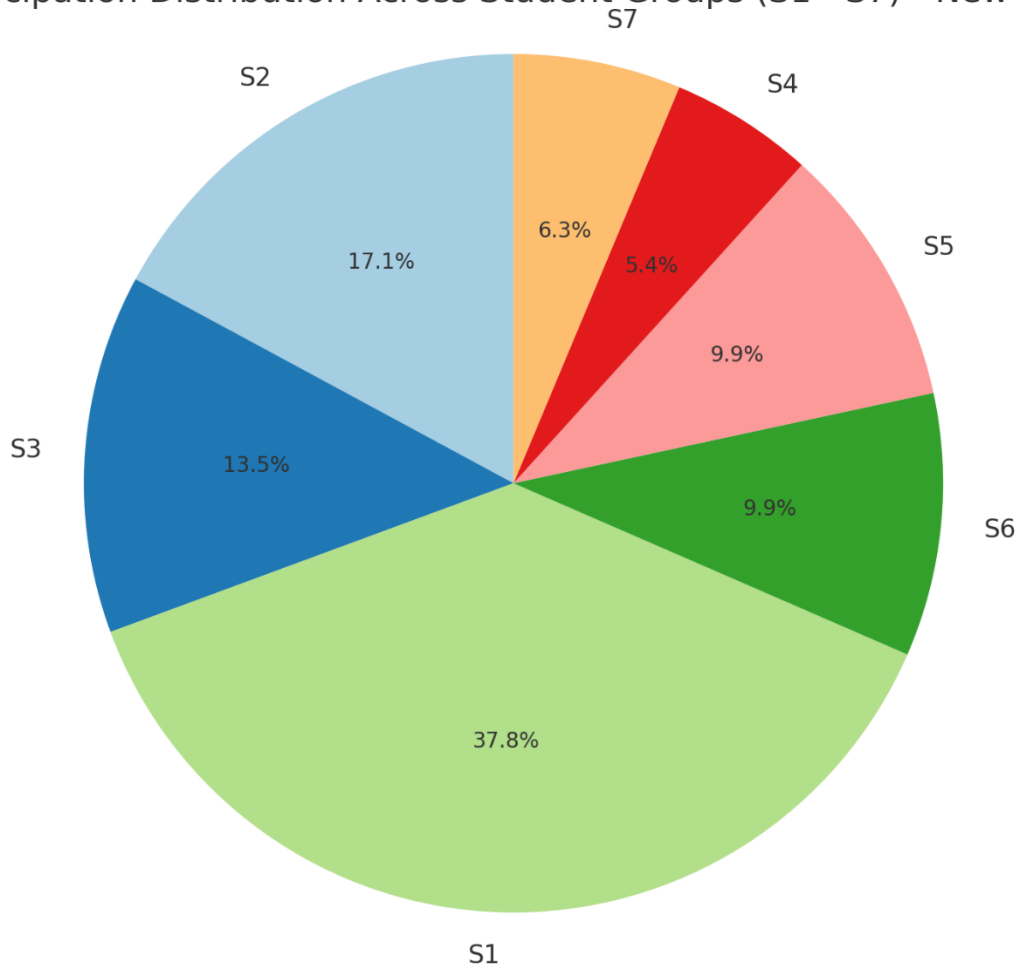
STEM

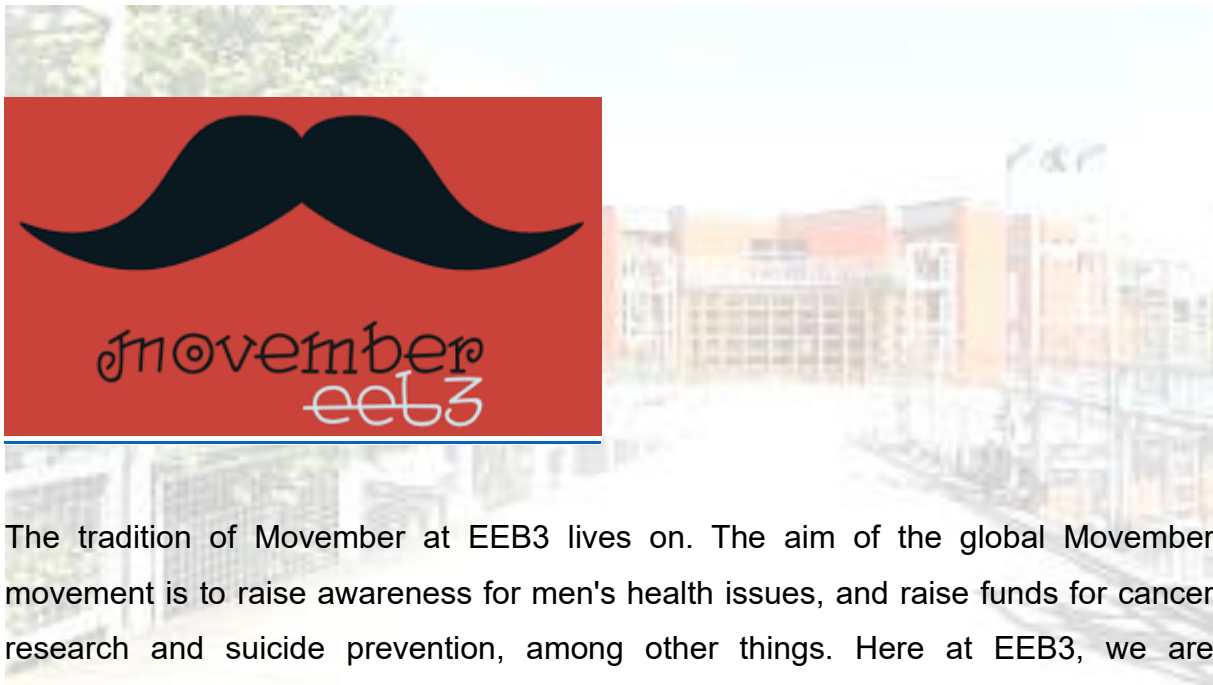

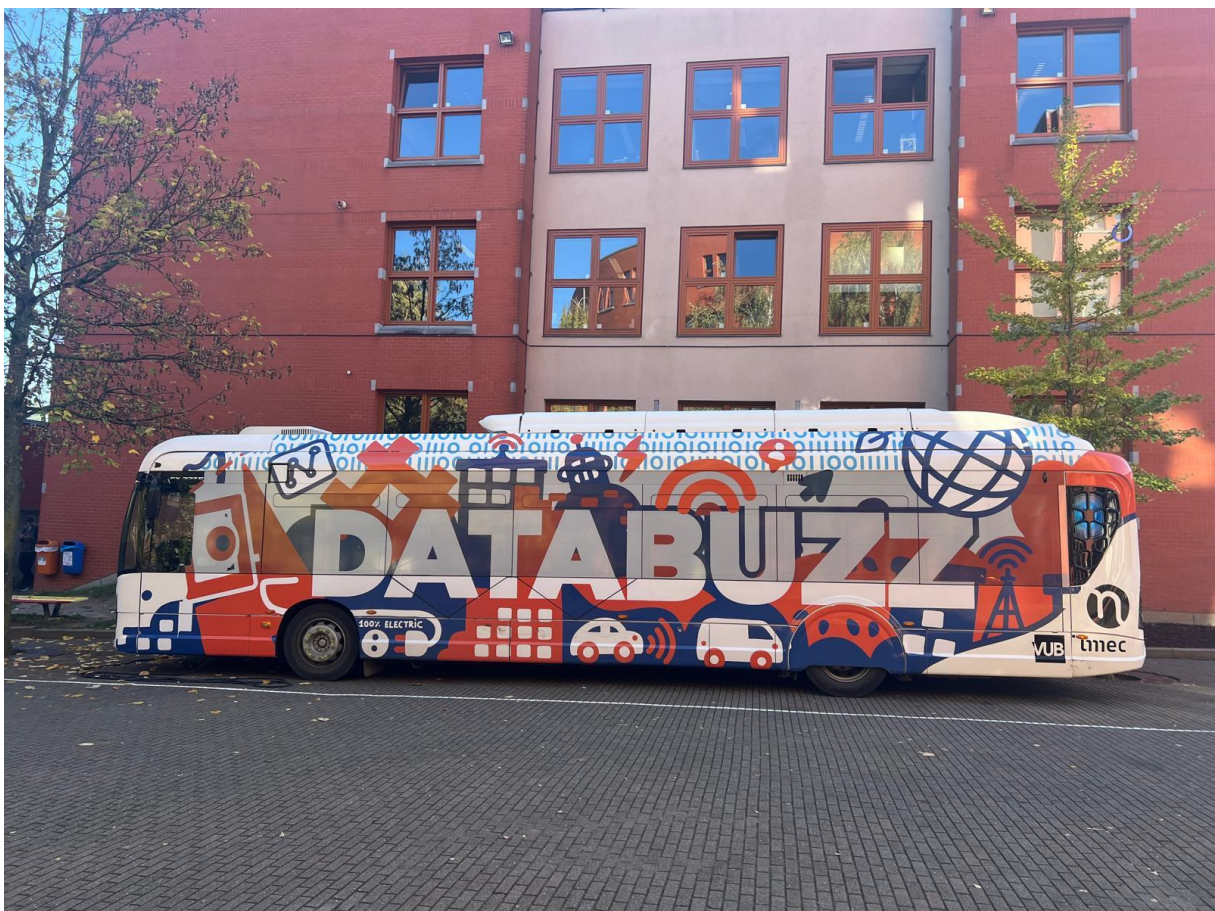
Are you an interested student, parent or staff member? Then grow a moustache in November and take part in the traditional parade on
