- University degree (validated by the national authorities) permitting to teach in the secondary school (until the Baccalaureate)
- Recent professional experience for at least 2 years in the secondary cycle (until the Baccalaureate)
- European citizen or person having a valid working permit in Belgium
- Ability to teach mixed classes using effective differentiation
- · Strong motivation in teaching in a multicultural and multilingual environment
- · Ability to work and to cooperate with colleagues, management and families
