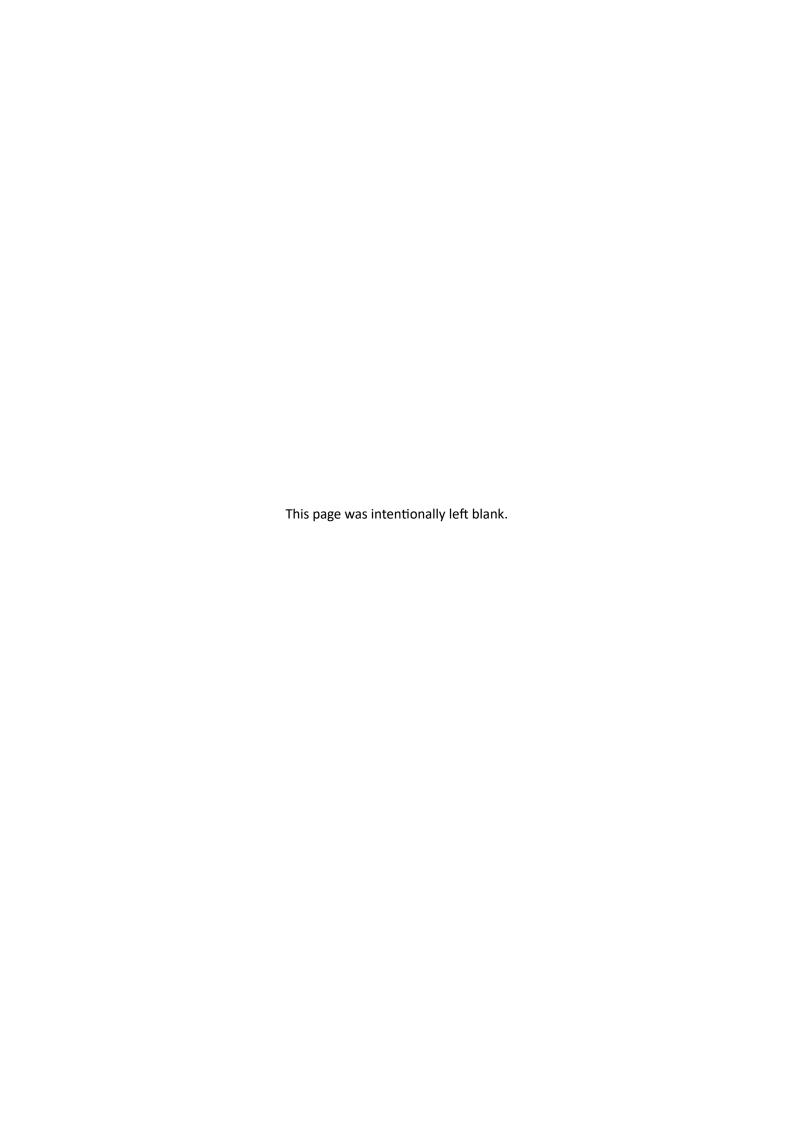

Introduction

Welcome to European Schools Self-Service Password Reset!

This guide is designed to help you register your account, use the password reset functionality and provide you with the ability to change your password in case you have forgotten it, ensuring you can change and reset your password by yourself with ease and confidence.

What is Password Reset?

Password Reset is a platform accessible via your web browser that allows you to change your password.

The main portal can be found at the below web address:

https://password.eursc.eu

Key Notes

- Accessibility: Password-Reset platform is ONLY available through our organization's network. This means that https://password.eursc.eu is reachable ONLY if you are in the office or connected to the organization's network through VPN. If you are trying to reach the website through any other network, it WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE.
- Account Name: To access the Password-Reset platform, it is required that you use
 your personal 6+2 account (6 first letters of your Last Name + 2 first letters of your First
 Name). If you are trying to login to the platform with any other account, it WILL NOT
 BE POSSIBLE.

Examples of 6+2 accounts:

plousami

pithiji

gonzalda

elmimowa

deborgje

ANY OTHER ACCOUNT IS NOT GOING TO WORK!

• Forgot Password Functionality: To be able to use the "Forgot Password" functionality, you must first go through the First-Time Login process. If you are trying to reset your password because you forgot and you have not done the First-Time Login process, you will not be able to reset your password.

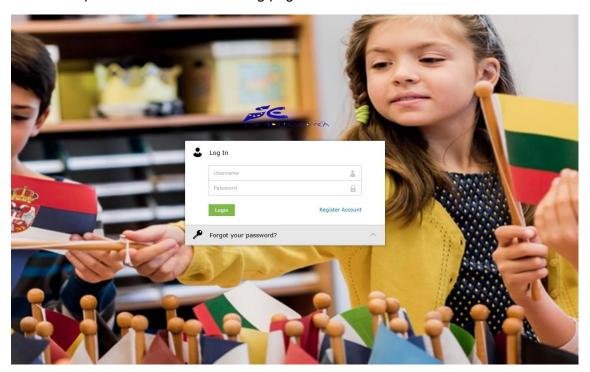

First-Time Login

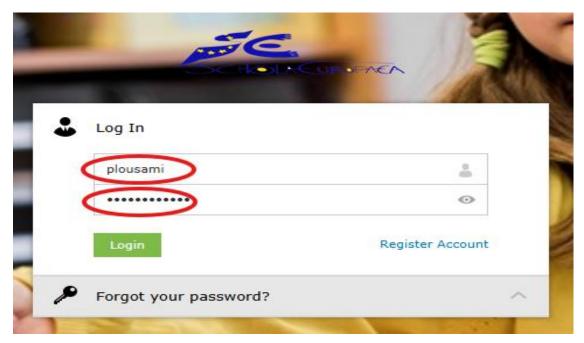
First you will need to visit: https://password.eursc.eu on your web browser.

(Please note that, in order to reach the above webpage, you MUST be connected to the organization's network, which means, you must be either in the office, or connected via VPN)

You will be presented with the following page:



You have to fill-in your username and password in the dialog box. **Again, remember, that you have to use your 6+2 username.**



You will then be presented with the following popup window:

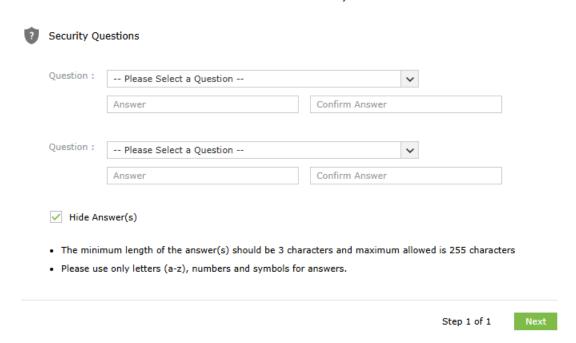

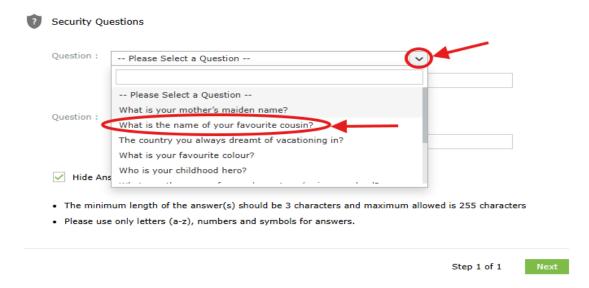


From this page, you will have to choose 2 security questions to be used in case you forget your password in the future. Please note that these questions **WILL BE USED** when you want to change your password in the future in case you have forgotten it.

In the below example the first question that was chosen was "What is the name of your favorite cousin?"

Please enroll for the forced verification methods enabled for your account.

After the first question is chosen, you will have to fill-in the "Answer" and "Confirm Answer" textbox with **exactly** the same answer. In our example, we will be using "Michail" as the answer. Please remember that the text that you are going to use is **CASE SENSITIVE** (This means that you have to use the exact same format, ex. Capitals or lower-case characters)

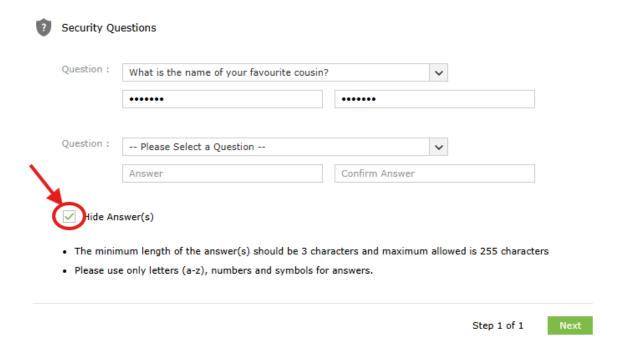

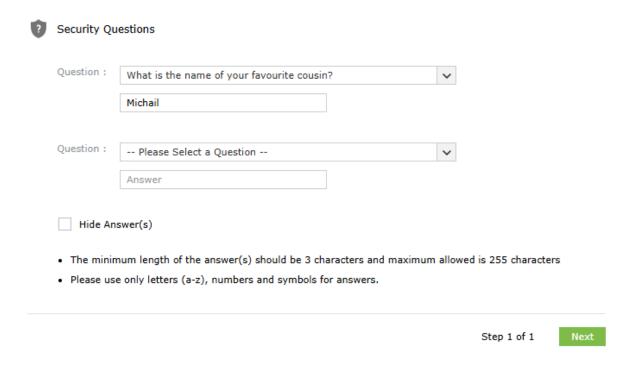
If you need to check the answers you have written, you can un-check the "Hide Answer(s)" checkbox.

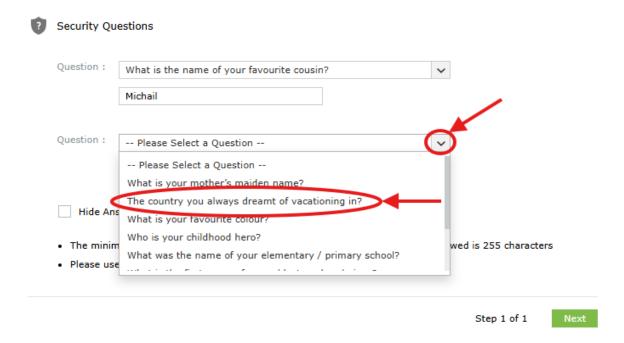
After the checkbox is unchecked, you will be able to view the answers you have written.

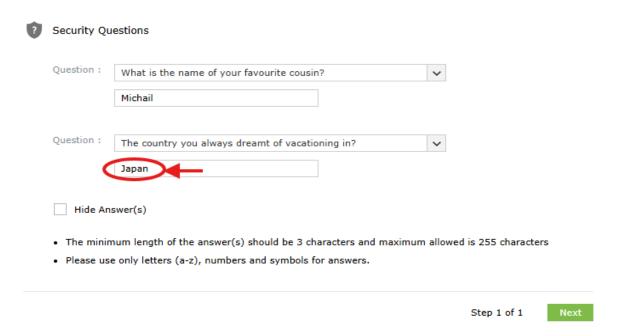
In our example, the second question we have chosen was the "The country you always dreamt of vacationing in?"

Please enroll for the forced verification methods enabled for your account.



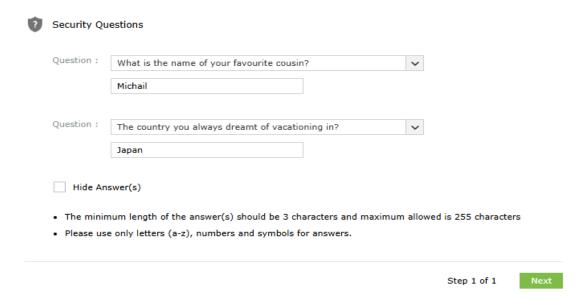
After the first question is chosen, you will have to fill-in the "Answer" and "Confirm Answer" textbox with **exactly** the same answer. If previously you have unchecked the "Hide Answer(s)" checkbox, then you will only be presented with one textbox only. In our example, we will be using "Japan" as the answer.

Please enroll for the forced verification methods enabled for your account.



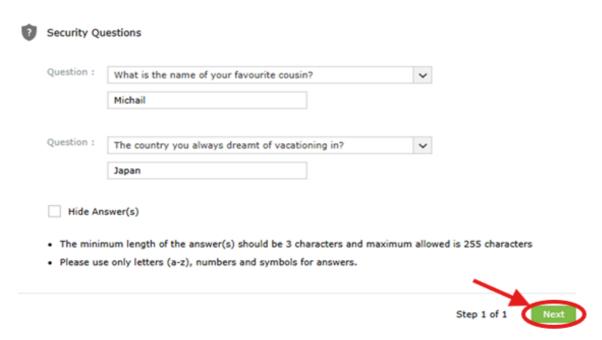
At the end, the form would be like the following:

After that, you will be presented with the following popup:



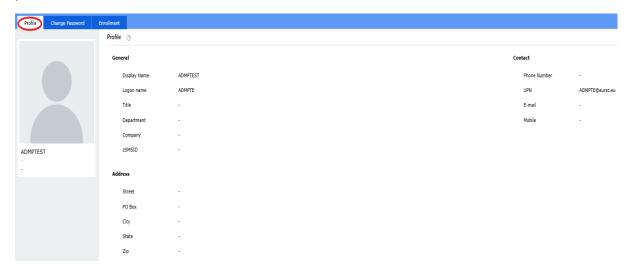
After seeing the above message, it means that you have successfully registered your account to the Password- Reset platform.

Usage Of The Password Reset Platform

The usage of Password Reset platform will be focused on two main categories.

- 1. Change Password
- 2. Enrollment

However, in the main page when you login, you will be landed on the "Profile" section of the platform.



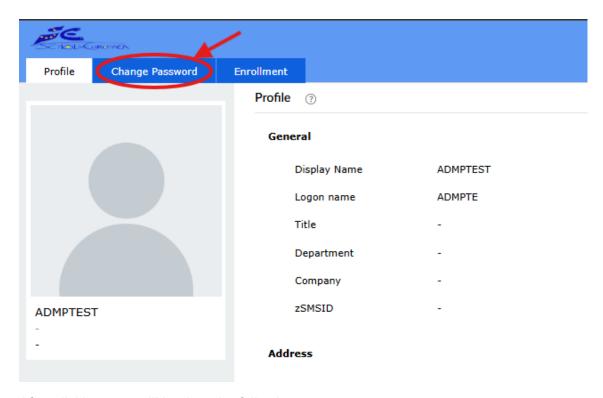
In this page you will be able to see some details for your profile. Also, in this section you can upload a new Profile Picture, but this configuration is out of the scope of the current guide.

In the "Change Password" section you will be able to change your password to a new one. In the "Enrollment" section you will be able to change your security questions.

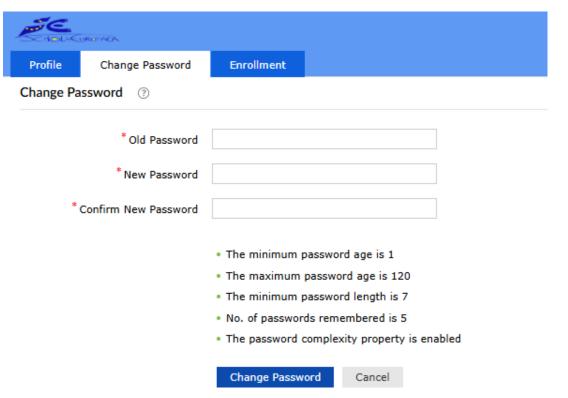
"Change Password" Section

As mentioned before, in this section you will be able to change your password.

First, you will have to click on the tab on the top, mentioned as "Change Password".

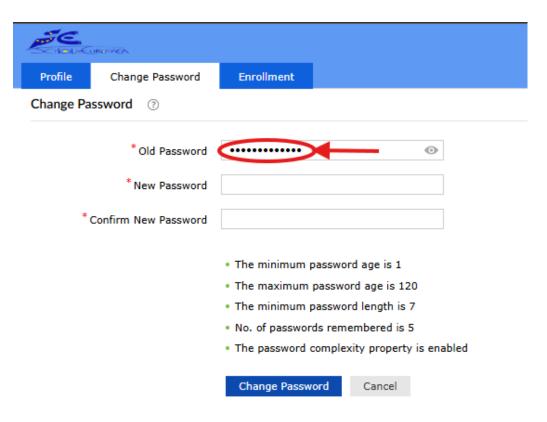


After clicking, you will land on the following page:

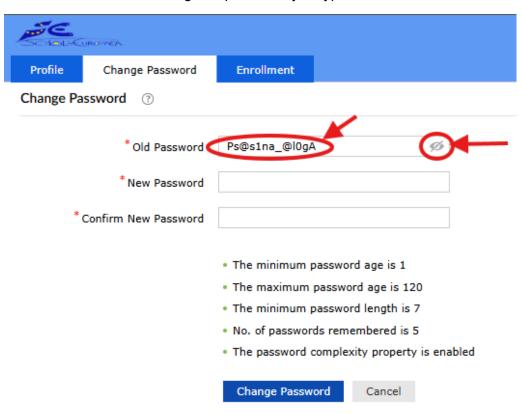


In this page, in order to change your password, you must do the following steps:

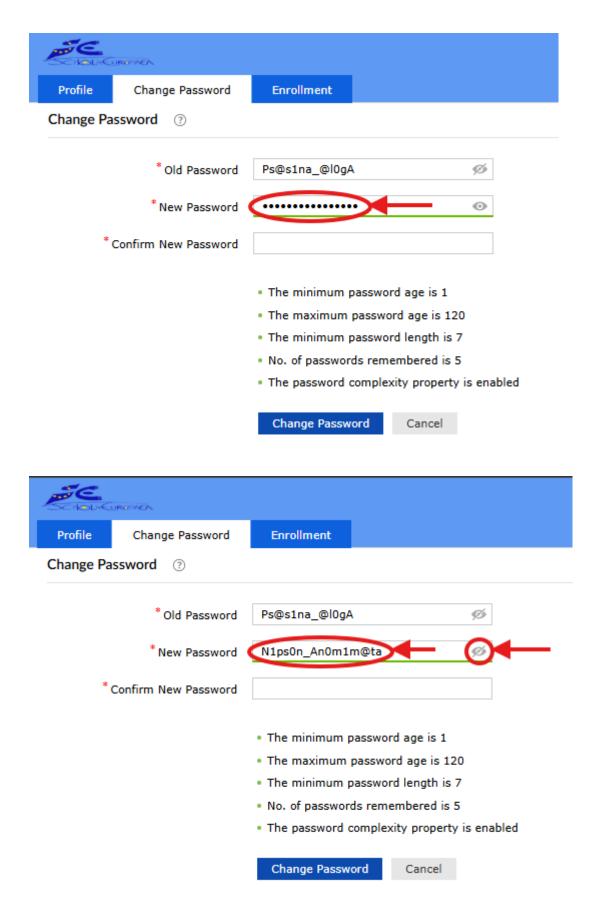
1. Put your old password on the first textbox.



You can click on the "eye" icon if you want to make sure that the password you have typed is the correct one. After clicking, the password you typed will be revealed.



2. Put your new password on the second textbox. Again, if you wish to view the password that you have typed, you may click on the "eye" icon.



At this point, we will explain in detail the requirements for the new password.

a) The minimum password age is 1.

This means that you can only change your password after 1 day since the last time you have successfully changed your password.

Example:

I successfully changed my password today (02 April 2025) at 16:00.

I **CANNOT** change my password again today!

I will be able to change my password after 24 hours have passed. This means that the system allows me to change my password **AFTER** 03 April 16:00

b) The maximum password age is 120.

This means that my password will expire after 120 days. After the 120 days have passed, you will be forced to change your password.

c) The minimum password length is 7.

This means that your new password must be at least 7 digits/characters in length.

Examples of **ALLOWED** passwords:

K0kk1N0\$ (length = 8)

P1@nit@rh1s (length = 11)

N1p\$on @n0mIm@t@ (length = 16)

Examples of **NOT ALLOWED** passwords:

M1ke7 (length = 5)

Ge0rge (length = 6)

Ann@4 (length = 5)

d) No. of passwords remembered is 5.

This means that you are not allowed to use passwords that you have used before, with the limit of 5 passwords.

Example:

1st password change at 11/04/2025 using the password: K0kk1N0\$

2nd password change at 13/04/2025 using the password: P1@nit@rh1s

3rd password change at 15/04/2025 using the password: N1p\$on_@n0mIm@t@

4th password changer at 17/04/2025 using the password: K@I0 Xwr1o

5th password change at 19/04/2025 using the password: I3r@p3tr@

<u>You can not use ANY of the previous passwords</u> when you will make your 6th password change.

6th password change at 21/04/2025 using the password: R3th!mn0

After the 6th password change that you have made, you are allowed to use the 1st password that you have used before.

7th password change at 23/04/2025 using the password: K0kk1N0\$

e) The password complexity property is enabled.

This means that every password that you are going to use **MUST** meet a certain complexity.

- A. Password length >7 (as mentioned before)
- B. Capital letters
- C. Lowercase letters
- D. Symbols
- E. Numbers

Examples of **ALLOWED** passwords:

K0kk1N0\$ (length = 8, Capital letters, Lowercase letters, Numbers, Symbols)

P1@nit@rh1s (length = 11, Capital letters, Lowercase letters, Numbers, Symbols)

N1p\$on_@ (length = 8, Capital letters, Lowercase letters, Numbers, Symbols)

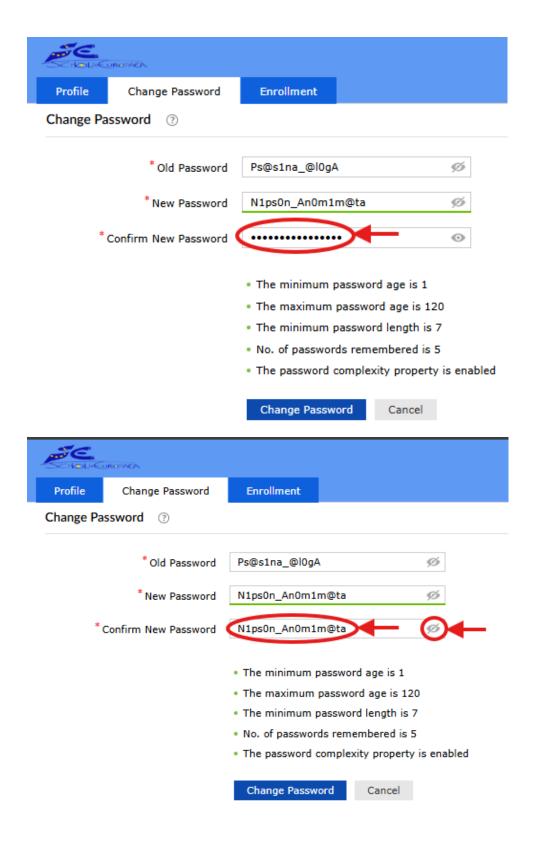
Examples of **NOT ALLOWED** passwords:

mike (length = 4, NO Symbols, NO numbers, NO Capital letters)

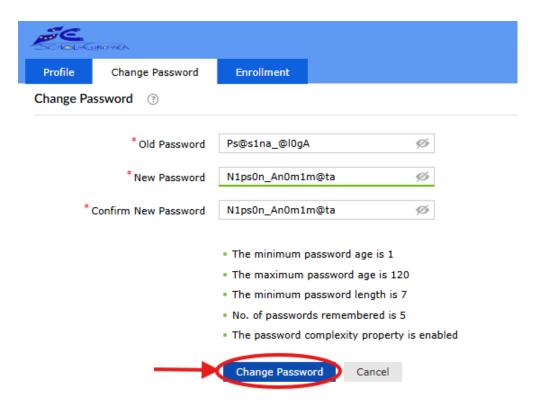
Ge0rge87 (length = 8, NO Symbols)

Ann@ (length = 4, NO numbers)

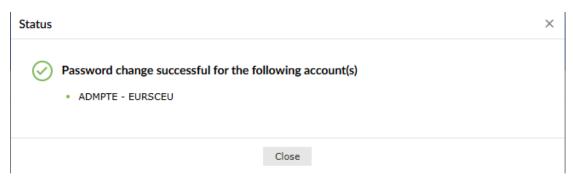
3. At this point, you will need to re-enter your new password on the third textbox. The password must be <u>exactly the same</u> as the one you entered on the second textbox. Again, if you wish to view the password that you have typed, you may click on the "eye" icon.



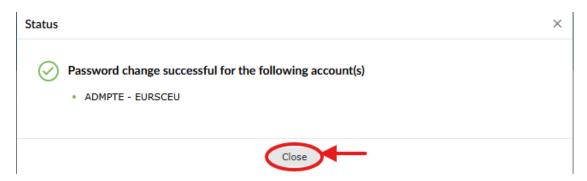
4. Then, you must click on the "Change Password" button.



5. After clicking the above button, you should be able to see the below pop-up window:



6. Click on the "Close" button.

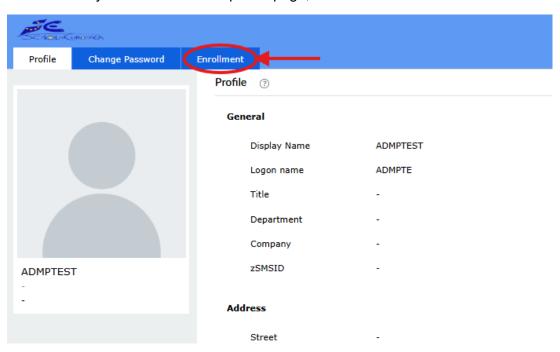


7. You will be then transferred to the main profile page. You have now successfully changed your password!

"Enrollment" Section

In this section you will be able to change your security questions.

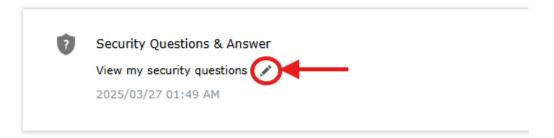
1. While you are on the main profile page, click on the "Enrollment" button.



2. In this section you will have the option to remove or modify your security questions. To do so, click on the "pen" icon.

You'll be asked to verify your identity using any of the methods listed below. Learn more

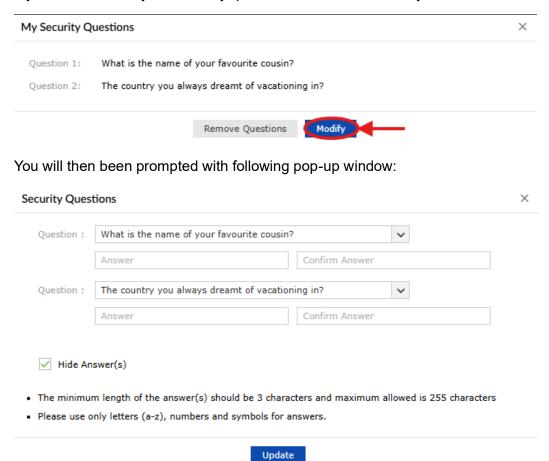


3. You will be presented with a pop-up window, allowing you to choose if you want to remove your security questions, or to modify them.



Option 1: Modify the Security Questions

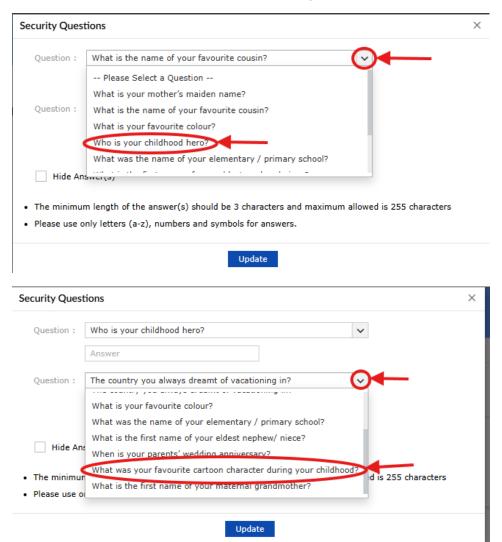
If you want to modify the security questions click on the "Modify" button.



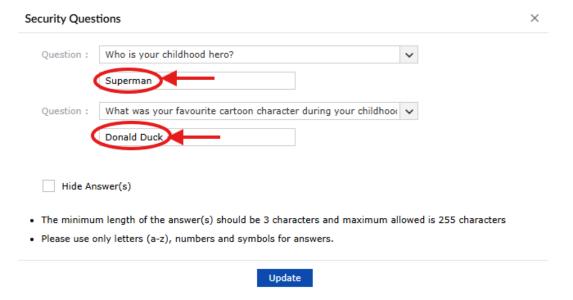
Here you also have the option to view the answers that you are giving by un-checking the "Hide Answer(s)" checkbox.



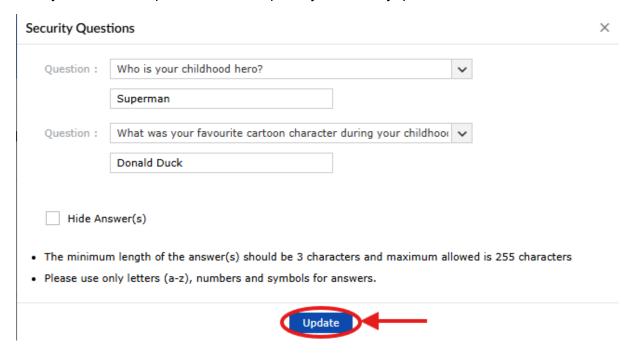
You can choose different questions now by clicking on the arrow where you will be presented with a dropdown menu of the available security questions.



Fill-in the textboxes with your answers.



Finally click on the "Update" button to update your security questions.



After that you will be presented with the following pop-up window meaning that you have successfully modified your security questions.



Option 2: Remove the Security Questions

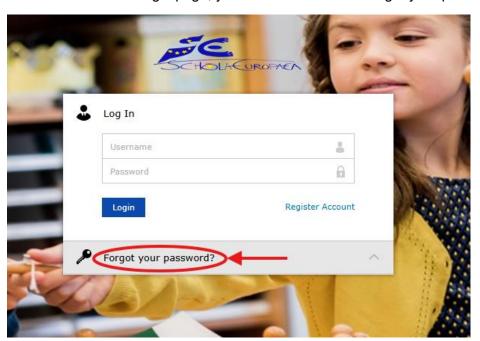
At this point, you are **NOT ALLOWED** to remove the security questions for security reasons. For any kind of modification, please refer to Option 1 of this guide.

"Forgot your password?" functionality

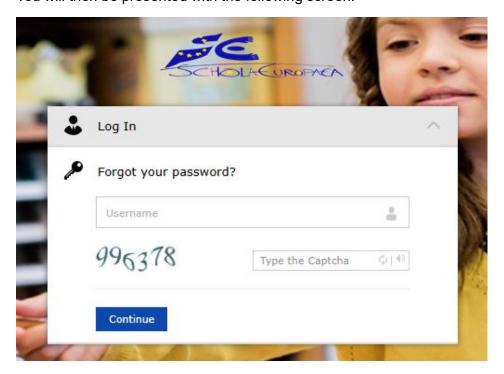
In case you have forgotten your password you are able to use the "Forgot your password?" functionality of the Password-Reset platform.

Please note that this functionality is available for you **ONLY AFTER** you have successfully completed the initial Login process.

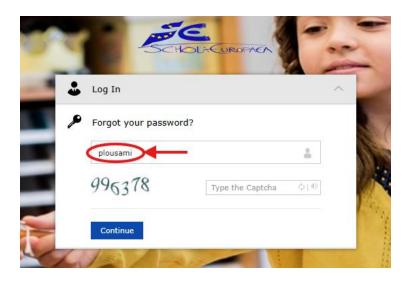
1. On the initial login page, you must click on the "Forgot your password?" hyperlink.



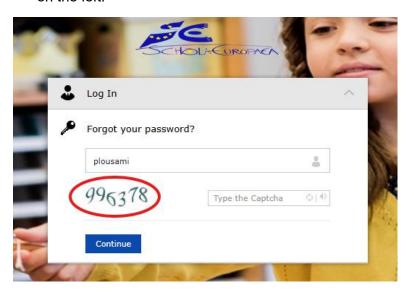
You will then be presented with the following screen:



2. In the first textbox you must input your username. (This means that you will have to put your 6+2 account name)

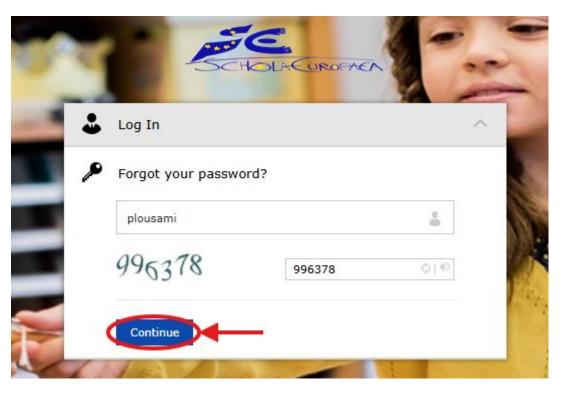


3. In the textbox that writes "Type the Captcha" you must input the numbers that are shown on the left.





4. After filling the textboxes, click on the "Continue" button.

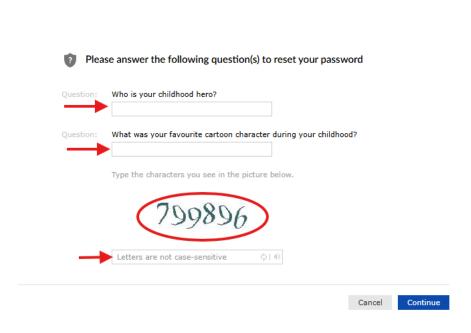


5. You will be then redirected to the following page:

6. On this page you will have to answer the security questions and input the characters that are shown on the bottom. Be very careful that this is timed-session (you can see the time left on the top right of the page), so it will expire after the time is finished and you will have to start over.

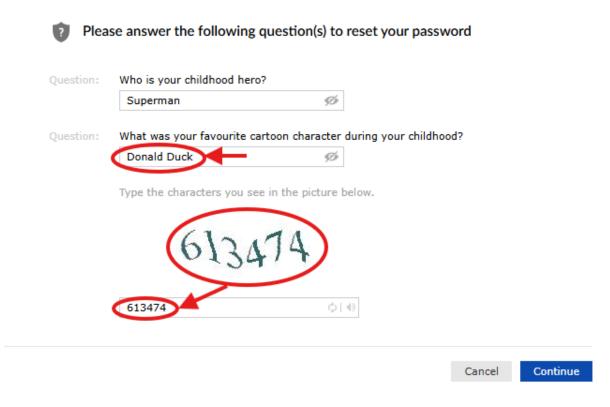




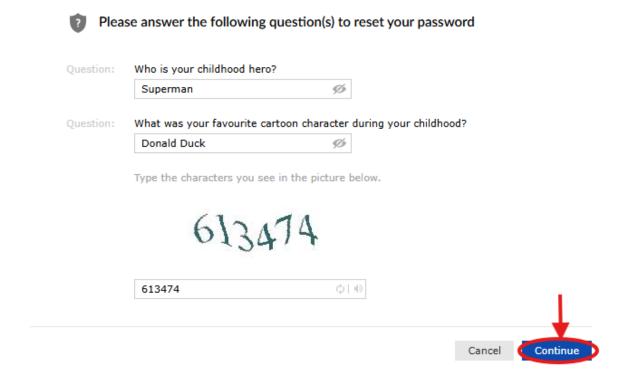
Note that you can always click on the "eye" icon to view the answers that you are typing.



Continue by filling in the rest of the textboxes.



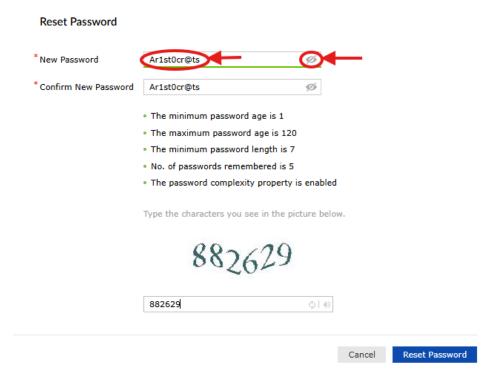
7. After you have filled in all the textboxes, click on the "Continue" button.



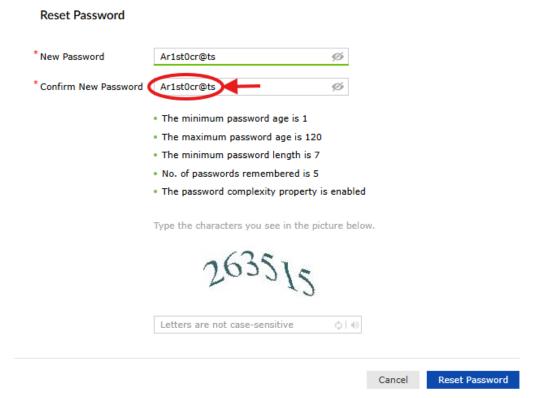
8. You will then be presented with the following page. Please note again that this is a timed session and the expiration time is shown in the top right of the page.

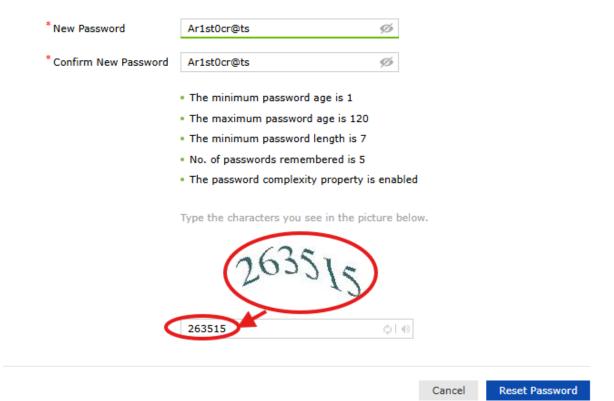


10. Continue by entering the exact same password into the second textbox.

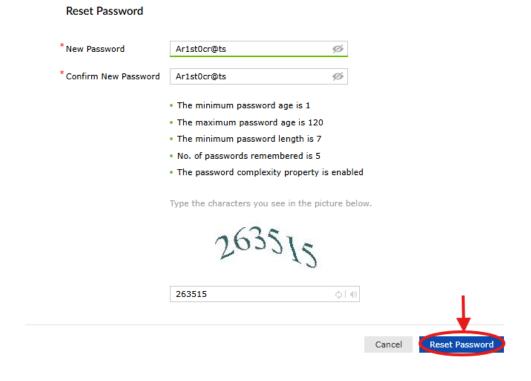


11. Then, you must enter the digits that are shown on the screen, to the third textbox.

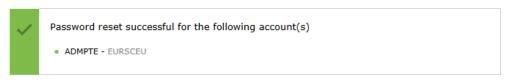

12. Finally, you must click on the "Reset Password" button.



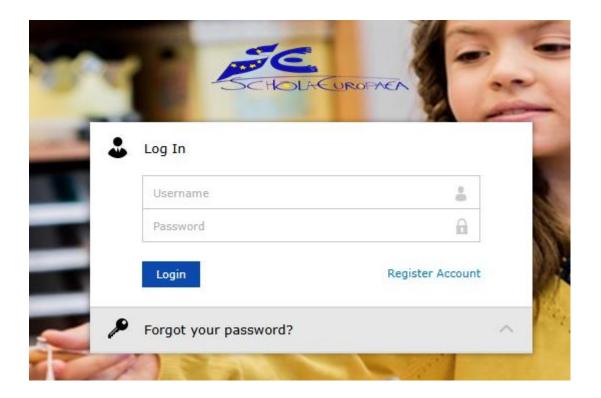
You will then be presented the following notification:
